Move makes Tutti's Dance dream a reality

Tutti Arts will add to its exciting suite of arts programs when it launches a new Contemporary Dance program later this month. Made possible by Tutti's move to new, larger premises at Brighton, the comprehensive program is for adults living with disability.

Tutti Arts CEO and Artistic Director, Pat Rix, says, "Artists have been asking us for a dance program for years and we have twelve people on our waiting list. Now that we have this wonderful new performing arts centre with a Tarkett dance floor, we can make it a reality."

Led by former principal dancer with the Finnish National Ballet, Juha Vanhakartano, experienced dancer-choreographer Juliette Griffin, and recent musical theatre graduate Brenton Shaw, each morning session will explore elements of contemporary dance through stretch, balance, body conditioning, and dance class. In the afternoon, the focus will be on the evolution of scenic choreography in dance and music theatre, and the development of new and original work.

Tutti's Contemporary Dance program will run on Tuesdays from 21 July 2020 onwards. Entry to the program is by audition, with a general audition to be held on Thursday 16 July from 3.30pm to 5.30pm.
