Accessibility Information

What can I expect at the Heart Beat Club?

<u>Tickets:</u>

- You'll need to buy a ticket via the website link before the Heart Beat Club starts.
- Tickets might be available at the door on the night unless they are sold out.
- If you have a Companion Card, you can bring someone along to support you without an extra ticket cost.

Music Volume:

- The music will be pretty loud to make the party more exciting.
- If you don't like loud music, you can bring your own ear protection.

Dance Floor Lights:

- The dance floor will have moving lights that change colour. But no flashing/strobing ones
- It's going to look cool with different kinds of lights.

Chill Out Zone:

- There's a quiet spot outside the venue with seats and umbrellas.
- It's a calm place if you need a break from the main event.

Other Entertainment:

- If you're not into dancing, there are arcade games to play.
- You can have fun in different ways if dancing isn't your thing.

Drinks:

- You can buy drinks at the bar, both alcoholic and non-alcoholic.
- If you want to buy alcoholic drinks, they might ask for your ID to show you are over 18 years old.
- You can't take your drinks outside.

<u>Food</u>

- You can buy bags of chips at the bar. But there isn't any other food available.
- There are places to eat nearby in Hindley Street.

Seating:

• There will be some seats at the venue, but not very many.

• There is a big space for the dancefloor, so bring your dance shoes.

Wheelchair Access:

• Wheelchair access is via the front entrance.

Accessible Bathroom:

- There's a wheelchair-accessible bathroom nearby. It is across the paved courtyard opposite the entrance. It is approximately 15m away.
- Heart Beat Club volunteer staff will be nearby to show the way.
- Other bathrooms are inside the venue.

Entry/Exit:

- You can come and go as you like during the event.
- If you need to leave and return, we might stamp your hand so you can get back in easily.
